Specifically the project aims at enhancing employability skills and support access to job opportunities as well as making small and medium sized businesses of Juakali artisans more competitive. The project is part of **"The Employment and Skills for Development in Africa (E4D) programme"** commissioned by the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and co-funded in Kenya by the European Union (EU), the Norwegian Agency for Development Cooperation (NORAD) and the Korean International Cooperation Agency (KOICA). It is implemented by the Deutsche Gesellaschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) GmbH in partnership with Pamoja for Transformation Trust in Kisumu County.
